Class outline,goal

In this class, students will understand the qualities and abilities that should be nurtured in

kindergartens and nursery schools. Next, students will deepen their understanding of the aims and contents of the area of "language" in the course of study for Kindergarten, Childcare guideline, Guidelines for Education and Nursery Care at Certified Childcare Centers. In addition, students will learn early childhood education techniques and teaching methods based on the development of language in children, assuming specific teaching situations.

- 1. Understand the aims and contents of the area of "language" based on the basics of education and childcare as stated in the Course of study for Kindergarten, Childcare guideline, Guidelines for Education and Nursery Care at Certified Childcare Centers.
- 2. The purpose of this class is to help students understand the development of language in children. In addition, to understand the content that children should experience and acquire, and the points to keep in mind as a caregiver in teaching and the concept of evaluation.
- 3. Students are expected to understand the structure of an instructional plan, envision specific educational situations, and acquire the early childhood education skills to create an instructional plan.
