Class outline,goal

In this class, the following objectives will be achieved through a play store event and children's festival. (1) To understand the characteristics of corrugated cardboard and to be able to create corrugated cardboard playground equipment that considers children's safety and the development of play. In addition, through the management of the events, they will enhance their sense of collaboration and practical skills.

(2) To develop the ability to conduct child-centered education by examining how cardboard play equipment is accepted by children.

(3) Acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to realize the "Expression" area.

Class plan

1. Making a product (corrugated fiberboard house) for a play store (1) <Characteristics of corrugated fiberboard, how to use tools, making the shape of the base>.

2. Making a product (corrugated fiberboard house) for a play store (2) <How to make a roof and windows and ensure safety>

3. Making a product (cardboard house) for a play store (3) <Thinking of a shape that reflects the child's play

4. Making products (cardboard houses) for a play store (4) <Making posts, chimneys, and counters>

5. Preparations for the "Play Store" event

6. Management of the play store event and the cardboard house making course

7. Review of the play store event and making cardboard playthings (kitchen and furniture) (1) <Researching and deciding what to produce>

8. Making cardboard playthings (kitchen & furniture) (2) <Making blueprints or miniatures>

10. Making cardboard playground equipment (kitchen and furniture) 4 <assembling>
